Please remember to RSVP before every service. Register from your email inbox invitation. There will be a limited total occupancy of 50 inside the Sanctuary.






Please wear a mask

A Step-by-Step Guide



PLEASE WAIT AT THE FRONT DOOR

Parishioners will be greeted at the door and ushered inside <u>one party at a time</u>, keeping safe distance.

DO NOT rush into the church! Take your time, you are not late.

Next, everyone will Sign-In and have their temperature checked.

To keep traffic moving, do not congregate in the center aisle.

Remember to register your attendance before each service!





After signing in, your party will be ushered to an appropriate pew.

Everyone Enters through the CENTER aisle, and Exits through the SIDE aisles.

Please follow all floor markings and arrows for one-way traffic.

Pews are numbered and marked for safe distancing.

Please refrain from sitting in the outermost aisle seats.

Lectors will sit in the very front row to the right with access to microphones.





During the Peace, we will greet our church family with kind gestures while remaining at our seats.

HOLY COMMUNION

Father Guy will come distribute communion to you. Stay in your seats.

Save your disposable communion cups until the end of the service. Father Guy will collect them as you exit.

Again, DO NOT congregate at the door. Keep safe distances while exiting the church.

RESTROOMS

To access the restrooms, *Exit* through the front door of the Church and *Enter* through the front door to Feaster Hall.

Please Sanitize before entering and Disinfect after each use to help protect thy neighbor.





DISINFECTING VOLUNTEERS





- Disinfect before and after each service
- First Apply Gloves (pre-packaged individually for safe opening)
- Purell Sanitize Spray Bottle:
 - Safe for use on upholstery
 - Spray Pew Seat Cushions
 - Lightly spray, Do Not Saturate
 - Leave to dry
- Clorox Disinfecting Wipes
 - Safe on wood & microphones
 - 1 Wipe per Pew is fine
 - One side wipe front handrail
 - Flip over to wipe back edge of pew
- Disinfecting Spray Bottle
 - Safe on door handles, light switches
 - Spray onto paper towels for best use



Please return supplies in caddy bucket to the church after cleaning.

RESTROOMS

Men's & Women's

- First Apply Gloves
- Spray Bathroom Cleaner on all commonly touched surfaces (stall doors, sink knobs, toilet flush handles, handicap handrails, counters, etc.)
- Let sit for 10min to disinfect
- Spray to wipe with paper towel
